Reuse the bags you have at home and give the clothes to other people. You can reuse things more than once.</p>

(locutor)</p> <p>(speaker) Love Bottles - or "Botellas de amor" in Spanish - is a way of disposing single-use plastics by filling plastic bottles with them.</p> <p>The organization that founded them, which is called "Fill a bottle with love", organizes the collections of the bottles and gives them to a company that recycles them into plastic wood. That's not all! With the plastic wood from the bottles, and a few other materials, the company turns them into furniture, which is then donated.</p> <p>What are single-use plastics? (locutor)</p> <p>single-use plastics, are used only once before they are thrown away or recycled. These items are things like plastic bags, straws, soda and water bottles and most food packaging.
